Is your cancer or treatment of cancer making you Tired? Fatigued? Exhausted??
Cancer & treatments of cancer can cause unusual and persistent feeling of tiredness that is not relieved by rest. This constant feeling of tiredness can affect your memory and concentration, affect your daily function and affect your relationship with your loved ones. This may cause significant emotional distress.

Dr. Andrew Winokur at the University of Connecticut Health Center is conducting a study on Cancer-related tiredness. Eligible participants receive study medication and a placebo, medical and psychological evaluations at no charge. Participants will receive \$75 for every completed session (total \$ 300 for four sessions).
