Dr. Jayesh Kamath at the University of Connecticut Health Center is conducting a study to evaluate an Omega 3 fatty acid supplement (lovaza) as a treatment of Cancer-related depression and anxiety. Eligible participants will be randomly assigned to receive study medication or a placebo (inactive substance) or a standard antidepressant (escitalopram). All study medications and medical/psychological evaluations will be provided at no charge. Participants will receive a maximum total of \$100 divided over the study period.
